Check-In: Registration will take place Sunday, July 22nd from 1:00 – 2:00 p.m. in the lobby of Alumni Dormitory. At registration you will be given your room assignment, key and an itinerary for the week.

Check Out: Camp will let out on Wednesday, July 25th by 12:00 noon. You will be charged for any damage to your room.

Notes:

- All you can eat cafeteria-style meals will be provided in the air-conditioned Cheney Dining Hall located close to the International Dormitory. Meal services begin with lunch on Saturday and end with breakfast on Tuesday.
- The Linkletter Swim Center will be available for campers at designated times during the camp.
- Besides field space with approximately 15 goals, we have an artificial turf that will be used for practice.
- Each participant should bring the following equipment: goalie stick, helmet with approved throat protector and mouth guard, chest protector, protective cup, gloves, cleats (or turf shoes) and sneakers (for turf, indoor and recreational use), plus any other optional protective equipment. A bathing suit and comfortable summer clothing is recommended.
- Participants must provide their own bed linen, pillow, towels, toiletries, reading lamps, etc.
- Most rooms are double occupancy. Fans may be needed since the rooms are not air-conditioned.

Automobiles: All car keys must be turned over to camp staff at registration and will be returned at departure. For your safety and insurance reasons, you need to comply with this request.

Camp Store: The latest equipment, protective gear, lacrosse apparel, snacks and beverages will be available. The camp store will have some equipment available (including mouth guards) as well as a variety of t-shirts, shorts, etc.

Early Arrival – Air/Train or Bus Travel: If you plan to come to the camp by air, the closest major airport is Bradley International, located near Hartford, CT. Bus and train transportation runs to Springfield. Both stations are within five minutes of Springfield College. Our suggested company for your transportation is Valley Transport (800-872-8752 or 413-748-9700). We will provide food and lodging at no additional cost. However, please be sure to contact us and let us know the approximate time your child will be arriving.
